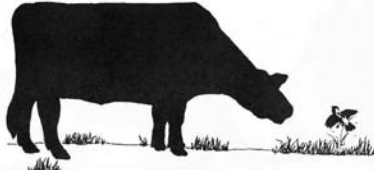

Directions to Sunny Valley Preserve:

From Eastern Connecticut:

- I-84 to Exit 7 NEW MILFORD/BROOKFIELD onto US-7 N - go 4.5 mi
- Turn **Right** on FEDERAL RD (US-7) – go 2.1 mi
- Continue to follow US-7 – go 3.8 mi
- Turn **Left** on SUNNY VALLEY RD – go 0.8 mi (Staples / Arby's on the corner)
- Turn **Left** on SUNNY VALLEY LN
- Arrive at 8 SUNNY VALLEY LN – Follow signs for parking in field.

From Southwestern Connecticut:

- Rt. 7 north to New Milford and follow direction as above.

From Northwestern Connecticut:

- Continue on Rt. 202 & Rt. 7 South about 1/2 mile to Sunny Valley Road.
- Turn **Right** on SUNNY VALLEY RD (There is a traffic light and McDonalds is on the corner.)
- Bear **Left** at stop sign continuing on SUNNY VALLEY RD
- Turn **Right** onto SUNNY VALLEY LN— Follow signs for parking in field.
