Call to Order: The meeting was called to order at 7:30 p.m. by Chairman Bob Kelly.

Minutes of the regular meetings held March 17, 2009: G. Bollard made a motion to approve the minutes of the regular meeting of March 17, 2009, with a correction. C. Read seconded. Unanimous approval.

New Business: none

1. Town of Bridgewater, Sarah Sanford Road East. Walking path at recreation center. B. Kelly and K. Vaughn looked at this project already. They reported that the proposal is for a foot path to go from the soccer field to the red facility building so the children can use the bathroom in the red building during soccer games and practice. There is a man made wetland that has been created by the drainage from the soccer field as well as two intermittent streams that will be affected. An old stonewall will be used as a base, then a layer of stone dust and a layer of loose stone. There will also be pipes for drainage. It was suggested to have a boardwalk for the last 50' and using stabilization fabric. B. Kelly, G. Bollard and D. Fitch will be case officers. It was suggested that the rest of the members look at the site as well.

2. Holland Joint Venture, 137 New Milford Road West, driveway. Bill Holland presented the application to the commission. Matt and Chris Holland were present as well. He is planning to expand Parker Medical but wants to do it in stages. The first phase is to be the parking lot. C. Read suggested that previous approvals for this property be reviewed. B. Kelly asked if there would be other wetlands issues beside the driveway. B. Holland said there would be. G. Bollard asked if this lot could be accessed from the other driveway to avoid the wetlands. It did not appear that would be possible. A. McNaughton felt the commission should look at the whole project. A. McNaughton will be the lead case officer. C. Read and V. Nelson will be case officers as well. The commission would also like to see engineer details, pipes and procedures.

Enforcement: K. Vaughn presented his report to the commission.

Procedural Matters: B. Kelly welcomed D. Fitch to the commission as an alternate.. He also noted that F. Sproviero was appointed as a voting member.
