**Approved Minutes of the Regular Meeting**

**Call to Order:** The meeting was called to order at 7:30 p.m. by Chairman Bob Kelly.

A. McNaughton was moved up to voting members.

**Minutes of the regular meetings held April 21, 2009:** G. Bollard made a motion to approve the minutes of the regular meeting of April 21, 2009. S. Purdy seconded. C. Read, V. Nelson, S. Purdy, G. Bollard, F. Sproviero, B. Kelly were in favor. A. McNaughton abstained.

**Comments from the Public:** none

**Old Business:**

1. Town of Bridgewater, Sarah Sanford Road East. Walking path at recreation center. G. Bollard and D. Fitch met Bill Stuart at the site. They reported on their site visit. G. Bollard felt that there was already a prudent alternative to this proposal since there is an existing path and wetland crossing. There is a tumbled down wall which is to be used as the base for the proposed path. The wall goes about 60% of the length of the proposed path. D. Fitch felt that the wettest part of the path would be where the wall ends. There would have to be some cutting in order to be able to see along the path to the facility building. Any cutting would have to be done by hand. There was also discussion about putting down fabric and creating swales. The old stonewall will be used as a base, then a layer of stone dust and a layer of loose stone. There will also be pipes for drainage. G. Bollard would like to meet with the Recreation Commission to discuss this project further.

2. Holland Joint Venture, 137 New Milford Road West, driveway. Matt and Chris Holland were present for this application. A. McNaughton reported on his site visit. He felt that there is going to be significant activity and would require professional plans. There is a 2:1 slope to the wetlands. The plan should include the septic, utilities, deeps & percs, how many acres will be disturbed, cuts and fill, soil and erosion plan, stockpiling. Are they planning to blast or hammer? C. Holland stated that they are planning to expand Parker Medical but want to do it in stages and work with the Town. The first phase is to be the parking lot. C. Read wanted to see a construction sequence. He felt that with a grassy level area drainage would not be a concern.

But with a parking lot and other impervious areas drainage will be an issue. It was decided that the applicant will come back with a new plan to address these concerns.

**New Business:** none

**Enforcement:** K. Vaughn presented his report to the commission.

The foot bridge at Clatter Valley has been completed and the stop card received.

Loy Wilkinson had come into the office to speak with him. He will be giving K. Vaughn further information.

K. Vaughn will inspect the Karabelas property and report back to the commission.

**Adjourn:** C. Read made a motion to adjourn. G. Bollard seconded. Unanimous approval at 8:35 p.m. The meeting was adjourned.
