Call to Order: The meeting was called to order at 7:30 p.m. by Chairman Bob Kelly.

Roll Call and Designation of Alternates:

Present: Greg Bollard, Strother Purdy, Alex McNaughton (alt.), Bob Kelly

Absent: Curtis Read, Frank Sproviero, Denise Fitch, Vic Nelson, Lori Franklin (alt.).

A. McNaughton was moved up to voting status.

Minutes of the regular meetings held March 16, 2010: G. Bollard made a motion to approve the minutes of the regular meeting of March 16, 2010. S. Purdy seconded. G. Bollard and S. Purdy were in favor. A. McNaughton and B. Kelly abstained

Comments from the Public:

Bill Stuart introduced Tony Bedini from the Region 12 Board of Education to the commission. T. Bedini asked to be added to the agenda to discuss repairs to the drainage system at the Burnham School. Discussion followed as to the issue of adding applications to the agenda since the issue could be controversial, no notice was given to the public and there was no opportunity for the commission to review the application. B. Kelly made a motion to add the application to the agenda for the purpose of previewing the plans for storm run of work at the Burnham School. G. Bollard seconded. Unanimous approval.

Old Business:

1. Artura/D'Alessio, Beach Hill Road, new single family dwelling. Steve Trinkaus was present for this application. He reviewed the changes he made to the driveway. Some of the changes he made on the plans were to add a 12' pipe under the driveway for the discharge of the drainage. Clearing will be minimized. The stream work will be done at the dry time of year. G. Bollard had been concerned about the fact that the property was originally two lots. They were joined during the sale of the property. He had felt the original driveway would have had too much blasting and disturbance. The vegetation around the vernal pool will be protected. Bio-filters will be removed. K. Vaughn will monitor the sequence of construction. G. Bollard made a motion to approve the plan revised 3/22/2010 for Greg Artura and Patricia D'Alessio. Subject to General Provisions and the Wetlands Enforcement Officer being notified and doing inspections during construction. Also subject to landscape plan and final house plans to be reviewed by this commission. B. Kelly seconded noting that the applicant will have to comeback if the plan is altered. G. Bollard, S. Purdy and B. Kelly were in favor. A. McNaughton abstained.

New Business:

1. Town of Bridgewater, drainage at Burnham School. Tony Bedini asked for this item to be put on the agenda. The commission will look into whether or not they can receive an application the night of the meeting. The proposal is to remove plants around the building, slope the grade and run drains to the driveway to catch basins. A. McNaughton and G. Bollard will be case officers.

Enforcement: K. Vaughn was not present. The commission discussed his report.

Procedural Matters:

A. McNaughton asked that the corrections from the previous month's minutes be included in the next month's minutes.

Other Business:

The commission received correspondence concerning treating White's Pond and Lake Lillinonah.

Adjourn: A. McNaughton made a motion to adjourn. G. Bollard seconded. Unanimous approval at 8:30 p.m. The meeting was adjourned.
